Music Department

- Three areas of Focus
 - ❖ Choirs/Organists/Choir Masters & Leaders
- Choirs
 - ❖ There will be active engagement of the choirs by organizing
 - ❑ Concerts in Hymns (Live not just Virtual)
 - ❑ Songs (Anthems) by SDA Musicians from the 1990s
 - ❑ Celebrate SDA Composers
 - ❑ Appraisal of Choirs through the above activities
 - ❖ Learning of Tonic Solfa (selected members by each choir)
 - ❖ Stage Performance through Workshops
- Organists
 - ❖ Teach techniques of playing for worship through workshops
 - ❖ Focus will be on those who already play
 - ❖ Frequency of workshops will be determined by the Music Director and participating organists

These will be organized every 6 months

Music Department

- Choir Masters & Leaders
 - ❖ Training Leaders on Choir Management
- Last meeting in each Quarter designated for Music Department to implement some of the proposed activities

Secretariat

- Annual Membership Update
 - ❖ Each Choir to provide membership update annually by January 15
- Minutes
 - ❖ Made available two weeks after each meeting
- Meeting Schedule
 - ❖ Provide a Meeting Calendar for the upcoming year by December 15
- Communication
 - ❖ Send meeting reminders at least one week ahead
 - ❖ Ensure all Union information is communicated timely
- Set-up a Cloud Repository for all Union Documents and Correspondence
- Review and Update of Constitution, as applicable

Chaplaincy

- Quarterly Spiritual Upliftment Series
 - ❖ My Music and my ... (Spirituality, Sabbath Keeping, Finances, Home, etc.)
- Devotion for Meetings
 - ❖ The Chaplain may assign choir leaders to lead as needed
- Evangelism
 - ❖ Plan an evangelistic crusade in Ghana during the two-year term
- First 30 minutes of Second meeting in each Quarter designated for Spiritual Upliftment

Media/Communication

- Setup a Media Committee for the Union
 - ❖Oversee all streaming and media needs within the Union
- Record all events of the Union and Archive them
- Secure Cloud Services to store Union recordings
- Purchase Equipment/Software for the Union Programs
 - ❖Cameras, Tripods, Hard drives, etc.
- Enhance the Social Media handles of the Union
 - ❖Facebook, YouTube, etc.
- Complete the development of a Website for the Union

- Enhance Dues Collection among Union members
